- will receive follow up to discuss progress using the strategies taught at the workshop.



**Sally Burton-Hoyle, Ph.D.** Assistant Professor, Special Education, Eastern Michigan University and Chair of the Autism Dept. She is known for her work with siblings, transition plans, self determination, and behavior management. She developed a masters program in autism and has done extensive work with children with emotional disorders and developmental disabilities.



**Christine Curry, M.S.**, Director of Families Together for People with Disabilities. She is a behavioral specialist for children with autism and conducts trainings for families and professionals on behavior management, developing behavior plans, and Special Education Law. Much of her work with families is done in homes where she is known as the Special Nanny.
